## Fieldwork Opportunity MacDonough Shipyard Vergennes

Issue: III-8

The Lake Champlain Maritime Museum just received an American Battlefield Protection Program grant to look for Macdonough's shipyard in Vergennes. The fieldfwork is scheduled for October 17-21. It is primarily a phase 1B land survey in the area where the shipyard is thought to have been, although an underwater examination of the river in that same area will be conducted. The work will be open to visitation by local schools, and there will be some level of participation from Northlands Jobcorps (the presumed site is behind their campus).
